



Al Shorta's Greatest Players - Number 43: **Zahrawi Jaber**



Abdul-Zahra "Zahrawi" Jaber was born in 1950 and started his career at Al Omma. In 1965, the striker signed for Quwa Al Siyara and four years later, at 19 years old, he signed for Shorta Al Najda, coached by Abdul-Kadir Zeinal. He was the league's top scorer in the 1973-74 season, even scoring four goals in a single match.

When Shorta Al Najda merged with Aliyat Al Shorta and Kuliya Al Shorta to form Al Shorta in 1974, Zahrawi was one of the club's key players and was the league's second-highest goalscorer in the 1974-75 season. The 1976-77 season saw him make history, becoming the first Al Shorta player to win the Golden Boot in the Premier League era, scoring six goals in eleven games to take home the award.

Zahrawi retired in the early 1980s and will forever be remembered in the history books as Al Shorta's first Premier League Golden Boot winner.
